

## NORTH EAST CENTRAL LABOR COUNCIL AWARD

The Northeast Central Labor Council will be presenting three randomly selected awards to qualified students during the 2013-2014 school year. The award will be valued at \$300 and be given in two installments. The first installment of \$100 will be given before Labor Day at the Riverwalk Labor Pod in Plattsburgh. The second installment of \$200 will be given at the Legislative Breakfast in the spring, date and location to be announced.

In order to be qualified:

1. You must return the completed application postmarked no later than July 8, 2013 to Liz Marshall, 67 Willow Street, Malone, New York 12953. Please do not include any other papers.
2. You must be enrolled in a two- or four-year college program, technical school, or apprentice program and be able to prove it if so requested.
3. You or a parent/guardian must be a member in good-standing of a union belonging to the Northeast Central Labor Council.
4. You or a parent/guardian must be available to receive the first part of the award in Plattsburgh before Labor Day and the rest of the award at the annual Legislative Breakfast in the spring of 2014.
5. You must prove the successful completion ( i.e. 2.0 grade point average or similar benchmark) of the first semester or similar evaluation period in order to receive the second installment.
